



Texas Financial Education Endowment (TFEE) 2020-21 Grant Cycle

Austin, Texas – TFEE is currently accepting 2020-21 grant cycle applications. In 2014, the Finance Commission launched a biennial grant program awarding endowment funds to organizations promoting the TFEE Mission to support statewide financial capability and consumer credit building activities. This grant program is designed to promote and support financial capability, education, and responsibility of Texans, by funding consumer credit building activities and programs for youth and adults throughout the state.

The Endowment Fund was created by the 82nd Legislature in conjunction with the legislation that established a regulatory program for Credit Access Businesses, which are financial service providers that facilitate payday and auto title loans. On June 21, 2019, the Finance Commission approved \$300,000 for 2020-21 grant awards.

Schools, governmental agencies, profit and not-for-profit organizations are encouraged to apply for grant awards through a competitive application and review process. Applications for funding consideration will be accepted between July 25, 2019 and September 20, 2019. Grant awards may range from \$5,000 to \$40,000. Selected grantees will be announced in early November 2019.
