



## Texas Financial Education Endowment (TFEE) 2020-21 Grant Cycle

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: September 30, 2019

Austin, Texas – The Texas Financial Education Endowment (TFEE) is extending the application period for its 2020-21 grant cycle. Applications are due no later than midnight, December 31, 2019.

Schools, governmental agencies, profit and not-for-profit organizations are encouraged to apply for grant awards through a competitive application and review process. Grant awards may range from \$5,000 to \$40,000. Selected grantees will be announced in February 2020, and the grant cycle will begin on March 1, 2020.

Organizations that submitted an application by the initial September 20, 2019, deadline are encouraged to review their applications and amend them if desired. Keep in mind the grant cycle will now run 22 months, rather than the initial 24-month period.
